

Watercolor Landscapes: Skies

Supply List

- Small set of watercolor paints (tube or pans) – Winsor & Newton Cotman Water Colour Sketchers Pocket box is a good option if you don't already have paints.
- Small tube of white gouache - Winsor & Newton Designer's gouache in permanent white is recommended.
- 140# Cold-pressed Watercolor Paper block or pad, size 9" x 12" (recommended brands: Strathmore, Canson, Fluid Easy-block).
- Watercolor brushes (synthetic brushes are economical and work well). If you have brushes feel free to use those. If you don't have any brushes the sizes below are a good set for painting skies.
 - #14 round (or a 1" flat brush)
 - #6 round
 - #1 round
 - #2 rigger or liner
- Plastic palette or disposable plate for mixing colors.
- HB or B graphite pencil
- Kneaded eraser
- Small container for water
